Pastor's Corner

Where Do Our Laws Come From?

By now we have all heard of the ruling, against Proposition 8. In that ruling the voices of 7 million Californians speaking out to continue to define marriage in the way that they have always known were deemed unimportant, as was thousands of years of human wisdom and tradition.



The case will churn its way through the courts for some time to come, but some of the reasoning behind the decision is particularly chilling. Judge Walker cited the fact that the opponents to homosexual marriage were opposed based on religious reasons. Such reasons were then rejected as illegitimate to state interest. This reasoning goes beyond the issue at hand and puts into question the very basis for human law in the first place. In other words, he is saying that laws that spring from "religious" motivations are not valid but that only secularism provides acceptable moral basis for law. When that is the rational, what basis do we have to trust the secular state when it says that it will not require religious officials to officiate in same sex marriages in violation of their religious tenants? He is in fact building the foundation for the state being able to find those religious tenants offensive and dismissible.

We have much to worry about in terms of the implications of this reasoning!

As time goes on it will get harder and harder for those who understand God's moral order to be laid out in His Word to see that order reflected in the laws of the society that we all hold dear. More than ever, let us be "salt and light" to

show that we are people of the Word of God and that God's laws represent loving guidance from our Heavenly Father who knows what is best for us.
