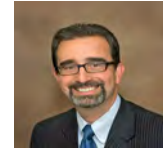

Pastor's Corner



The Graciousness of our Savior

We often speak of the grace of our Lord Jesus and by that we mean his willingness to grant us unmerited favor is salvation. But today I notice his graciousness in how he treats others. Specifically, I refer to his post resurrection attitude toward his disciples.

In John 20:17, speaking to Mary he refers to them as his "brothers". In John 20:19 he blesses them with the words "peace be with you". You may say "What's the big deal?" But remember these were the guys who ran from him, deserted him and denied him. They were hiding in fear and totally forgetting his prediction about resurrection. In short - you would think that at least a little rebuke was in order. That is what they deserved and what they have earned-Just like me. But none is forthcoming. There is only the grace of a gracious greeting. Jesus is a gentleman. I am glad to know that this is the way my savior reacts to my failure and that he can be trusted to treat his fallen followers gently.

Being a Considerate & Respectful Worshipper

(part 3)

In the last few months, I have outlined some pointers for behavior that will enhance and improve our experience in worship together. I do so as I note that guidelines for behavior in public gatherings seem to be lacking in general in our culture today. But they do matter!

So far we said...

1. Arrive on time.
2. Stay until the end
3. Turn off your phone.
4. No talking please!
5. Use the nurseries.
6. There is no such thing as "my seat".

This month I focus on some positive suggestions...

1. **Plan ahead** - If it appears to you that you may not be able to sit comfortably through the entire service, choose a seat near the rear of the sanctuary so that if you do have to leave, you will be viewed by as few people as possible.
2. **Use the 10-foot rule** - I like to remind people to greet all those with a friendly smile and handshake who come within 10 feet of you. If we all would practice that 10 foot rule, we would find greater warmth of welcome and relationships.
3. **Make room in your schedule** - You will be able to relate to the people in your church family more if you allow room in your schedule on Sunday so that you are not booking a "next event" right after the service. If you take a more leisurely approach to Sunday, you will be able to spend the time it takes to talk and get to know others.

These ideas may seem like common sense, but often they

are overlooked. As we all care about these issues we will demonstrate our consideration of others in worship.
