Pastor's Corner

Our Coming Victory

This month we will turn from the "things that are," section of the book of Revelation to the "things that will be," the prophetic section in chapters 4-22.

Many Christians avoid this section in their study because it is easy to become bewildered by the symbolism and imagery. But I believe that those who ignore the prophetic section of Revelation miss out on a rich treasure. Revelation reveals that God is in charge of all of history, it shows the depth of humanity's sinfulness and the reality of God's judgments. But it also shows the mercy, tenderness and love of God.

In the weeks ahead we will see the ultimate victory of Jesus over Satan and the final state where we will dwell with God in a new realm, called the new heaven and the new earth.

I trust that this will be a rich time in the word for you all.

Here are some pointers for the weeks ahead...

1. Please bring your Bibles and follow along in the passages that are read. Due to the fact that we will take just 8 weeks to move through the entire prophetic portion of the book, we will be doing more straight reading of the text and it will be better if you are able to follow along.
2. Realize that in order to cover the material at hand we will leave a slightly longer time period in the services for the messages of this series.
3. Expect both resistance and blessing. Satan does not want these things clearly explained and so he will establish difficulties to our study where he can. But God has promised blessing. It is remarkable what John says in the introduction to the book of Revelation...

"Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near." (Rev. 1:3)

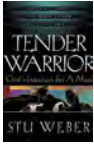
July 18 - Christina McBride assists Bob and Lisa Margaron at the Peniel Mission loving, teaching and mentoring the south Stockton inner city kids.

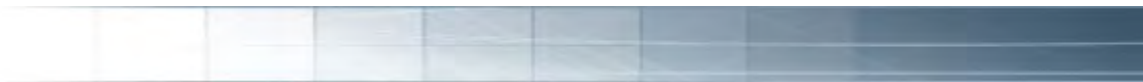
